RETROVET EU-FUNDED PROJECT – SUCCESSFULLY IMPLEMENTED

The Partnership announces the successful implementation of the EU-funded project RetroVET which fundamentally sustains the Green Deal in VET Provision.

For the last 2 years seven Partners from Estland, Italy, Germany, Greece, Poland, Portugal and Spain have been working at the development and implementation of the EU-funded project RetroVET (Project no. 2021-1-DE02-KA220-VET-000034687). Today the Partnership is looking back at the successful implementation of the Project.

The Project aims at adapting today's VET provision and jobs to meet the needs of the future European labour market, increasing long-term employability and sustainability. RetroVET directly supports the European Green Deal as a new growth strategy and recognises the key role of vocational training for a successful transition to climate neutrality by 2050.

A preliminary study conducted internally by the Partnership has shown the importance of a topic such as the »greening« of the VET field. Hence, the Partnership developed a modular platform with innovative content to enhance awareness and knowledge about »green« VET provision, as well as to support VET institutions in reaching out to like-minded VET centres.
