

About RetroVET Project

Throughout the **European Green Deal**, education is central to achieving the EU's climate goals. **RetroVET** is an **Erasmus + project** that directly supports the European Green Deal as a new growth strategy and recognises the key role of vocational training for a successful transition to climate neutrality by 2050. It involves **7 organisations** from **Germany**, **Poland**, **Estonia**, **Italy**, **Cyprus**, **Spain** and **Portugal**.

Thanks to the wide range of activities planned over the two years of implementation, the project aims to **adapt vocational training to future labour market needs** by supporting the development of **innovative tools.** These tools will inspire VET centres to offer a balanced mix of vocational skills linked to existing and evolving occupations and working methods.

The partnership is now finalizing the Result n. 1, the Best Practice Handbook on Green Skills integration in VET. The handbook will gather and analyse best practices in the implementation of "Green Elements" in VET. After completing the content, next stepswill be the translation into all partner languages and the final validation, which will be provided by five external experts in all countries involved.





As part of the Interactive Green VET Benchmarking Tool, 27 best practice guidelines have been developed from the key best practices gathered during the research carried out for the Best Practice Handbook on Green Skills integration. These 27 guidelines form the basis of the self-assessment questions and thematic areas.

The technical build of the benchmarking tool is in progress and will be ready for the first piloting phase in **January 2023**.

The 2nd TPM is coming up...

The 1st project meeting was held in Freising (Germany) in June 2022. 






The website is ready!
